



Marin Theatre Company's Teen Advisory Board is a group of passionate and dedicated high school students who serve as ambassadors between MTC and the teen community in Marin County. Teen Board members run the Marin Young Playwrights Festival, help plan MTC's summer programs; observe rehearsals for MTC mainstage productions; participate in discussions with MTC designers, actors, and directors; attend monthly meetings; and receive free tickets to MTC productions.

Requirements for Membership:

- Attend meetings (see dates below). **Teen Board members must clear their schedules for these meetings!** Occasional unavoidable absences may be excused, but members must plan to attend every meeting. Members who miss more than two meetings may lose their spot on the Board.
- Read and evaluate script submissions for the Marin Young Playwrights Festival. Choose the finalists. Possibly perform in one or more finalist plays at the Festival February 7, 2011. Possibly serve as liaison/producer for one of the finalist plays.
- Serve as liaison between MTC and your school, including:
 - Distribute information about MTC school programs, such as the Student Matinee series and the Marin Young Playwrights Festival, to the appropriate faculty or administration members at school. Encourage your school to participate in these programs.
 - Find out from your school if there are any unmet needs for theatre and arts programming, and communicate those needs to MTC. Encourage MTC to develop programming that would best serve your school's needs.
 - Recruit students from your school to participate in various MTC programs, such as the Summer program and the Marin Young Playwrights Festival. Distribute information about these programs to students at your school.
- Read scripts for consideration for Summer Camp and School Tour productions, and articulate your thoughts about these scripts to MTC and other Teen Board members at the meetings.
